No. 355. The Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938, the following Rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Nata, in the District of Paphos, are published in the *Gazette*. (M.P. 939/37.)

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF NATA.

Rules.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Nata (Amendment) Rules, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Nata Rules, 1937, (hereinafter called “the Principal Rules”), and the Principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Nata Rules, 1937 and 1939.

2. Rule 5 of the Principal Rules is hereby amended by the substitution of the words “four shillings” by the words “six shillings”.

3. Rule 17 of the Principal Rules is hereby deleted.
