In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 59 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Amendment (No. 4) Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Orders, 1939 to (No. 3) 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Orders, 1939 to (No. 4) 1939.

Pyrene Oil.

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)  
REGULATIONS, 1939.**

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.
