**No. 365. BY THE GOVERNOR.  
A PROCLAMATION.**

Whereas it is expedient that the two quarters in the village of Yialousa, in the District of Famagusta, known as Archangelos and Kalamia should be abolished.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, William Denis Battershill, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby proclaim that the said two quarters in the said village of Yialousa shall for all administrative purposes be abolished as from the 1st day of December, 1939, and that the said village of Yialousa shall rank as one village not divided in quarters, as from the above date.

**No. 366. BY THE GOVERNOR.  
A PROCLAMATION.**

Whereas it is expedient that the two quarters in the village of Apsiou, in the District of Limassol, known as Pano Apsiou and Kato Apsiou should be abolished.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, William Denis Battershill, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby proclaim that the said two quarters in the said village of Apsiou shall for all administrative purposes be abolished as from the 1st day of December, 1939, and that the said village of Apsiou shall rank as one village not divided in quarters as from the above date.
