NOTICE UNDER SECTION 11.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 11 of the Antiquities Law, 1935, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

From and after the date hereof no building shall be erected, reconstructed or repaired and no tree shall be felled within the area adjacent to an ancient monument to wit the church of Saints Barnabas and Hilarion situated in the village of Peristerona, in the District of Nicosia, comprising the plots specified in the Schedule hereto save in accordance with the terms of a permit in writing from the Commissioner previously obtained.

All that area of about 2 donums, 1 evlek and 1,400 sq. ft. in extent situated in the village of Peristerona, in the District of Nicosia, comprising the plots shewn on sheet XXIX, plan 3.6.II, of the said village, under the registration number set out against the number of each plot, that is to say:—
