

**No. 392.****THE MISSIONARY EDUCATIONAL AND MEDICAL (ALIEN  
REGULATION) LAWS, 1922 AND 1933.****ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1899**

Whereas in pursuance of the provisions of the Missionary Educational and Medical (Alien Regulation) Laws, 1922 and 1933, the persons whose names appear in the Schedule hereto have applied for permits under the provisions of the said Laws;

And whereas the said persons have severally given an undertaking in writing to pay due obedience and respect to the Government of Cyprus, and while carefully abstaining from participation in political affairs, that they desire and purpose *ex animo* to work in friendly co-operation with the said Government in all matters in which their influence might properly be exerted; and, in particular, they have undertaken that if engaged in educational work, their influence will be exerted to promote loyalty to the Government of Cyprus in the minds of their pupils, and to make them good citizens of the British Empire;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by the said Laws, and otherwise, and with the advice of the Executive Council, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to grant to the persons whose names appear in the Schedule hereto a permit respectively to commence or to carry on the work set down after their respective names.

**No. 393.****THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.****ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.**

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Ayios Theodoros, in the District of Larnaca, on the 30th day of April, 1939, it was determined by the requisite majority of the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Ayios Theodoros:

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have been fixed and described :

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Ayios Theodoros has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Larnaca a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, prescribed :

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor :

And whereas the Governor considers it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the area in the said report described should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Ayios Theodoros.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be and shall be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Ayios Theodoros, in the District of Larnaca.

#### SCHEDULE.

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at the most northern point of plot No. 224 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX/55, locality "Kaminia," on the road from the village of Ayios Theodoros to the village of Kophinou, and on the boundary of the former village, and proceeds north-eastwards and south-eastwards along the said village boundary to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 427 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX/56, locality "Laxia-tis-Panayias"; thence south-eastwards and south-westwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 427, 429 and 451 of the said plan, plots Nos. 11, 10, 9, 7, 5, 4, 74 and 76 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX/64, locality "Volikari," to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 76 of the said plan, on the footpath from the village of Ayios Theodoros to the locality "Papadhies"; thence westwards along the said footpath to the south-western corner of plot No. 69 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX/63, locality "Kapsalia"; thence northwards along the western boundaries of plots Nos. 69 and 68 of the said plan, to the most northern point of the latter plot, on a footpath; thence westwards along the said footpath to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 58 of the said plan, locality "Fourni"; thence north-westwards along the boundaries of, and including, plot No. 59 of the said plan, plots Nos. 387, 397, 388, 389, 390 and 370 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX/55, plots Nos. 39, 38, 36, 35 and 34 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX/63, plots Nos. 370, 362, 367, 368, 396, 252, 216, 212 and 214 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLIX/55 to the south-western corner of the last mentioned plot, on the road from the village of Ayios Theodoros to the village of Kophinou; thence northwards along the said road to the point of commencement; all which said area is 1,583 donums or thereabouts, as shewn edged in red on the plan filed in D.L.R.S. M.P. 506/39.
