A PROCLAMATION.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 17 of the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, I, William Denis Battershill, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 1st day of January, 1940 :—

1. The boundary of the town of Kyrenia shall be as set forth in Schedule A hereof ;
2. The town of Kyrenia comprised within the boundary aforesaid shall be divided into the quarters set forth in Schedule B hereof ; and
3. The Order made by His Excellency the High Commissioner dated the 4th March, 1924, and published in the *Gazette* of the 14th March, 1924, under Notification No. 146, shall be revoked.

SCHEDULE A.

Boundary of the Town of Kyrenia.

The boundary commences at the north-western corner of plot No. 15/3 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/12, on the seashore, and proceeds eastwards along the seashore to the mouth of the river "Yiatsime Deresi," Government Survey Plan No. XII/21 ; thence southwards along the left bank of the said river to the most southern point of plot No. 142/1 of the said plan, on the main road from Ayios Epiktitos to Kyrenia ; thence westwards along the said main road to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 161 of the said plan ; thence eastwards and southwards, along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 161, 165, 166, 170, 171, 172, 238, 239, 240, 243, 241 and 230 of the said plan, plots Nos. 31, 32, 34/1, 33, 34, 39, 40, 42, 44, 94, 95, 99, 100, 101, 106, 106/1, 106/4 and 106/3 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/29 to the most southern point of the last-mentioned plot on the track from the Nicosia-Kyrenia main road to Kazaphani ; thence south-eastwards along the said track to the stream "Potamos tous Mylous" ; thence south-westwards up the said stream to the most southern point of plot No. 12 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/37 ; thence northwards

and south-westwards along the northern boundary of plot No. 20 of the said plan to the main road from Nicosia to Kyrenia ; thence north-eastwards along the said main road to the most southern point of plot No. 4 of the said plan ; thence north-westwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 4, 3, 2/1, 2/2 and 1 of the said plan to the most western point of the last-mentioned plot, on a track from the house " Templestowe " to the main road from Kyrenia to Nicosia ; thence south-westwards along the said track and the said main road to the most southern point of plot No. 24 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/36 ; thence north-westwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 24, 23 and 22 of the said plan, plot No. 160 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/28, plots Nos. 21 and 21/1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/36, plots Nos. 159, 108, 107/1, 107, 91, 105, 95, 93 and 80 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/28 to the south-western corner of plot No. 121 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/20, on the stream " Kalava Deresi " ; thence northwards along the said stream to the lower road from Kyrenia to Templos ; thence south-westwards along the said road to the south-western corner of plot No. 67 of the said plan, which point is on a track leading to the main road from Lapithos to Kyrenia ; thence north-westwards and north-eastwards along the said track to the said main road ; thence eastwards along the said main road to the south-western corner of plot No. 26/2 of the said plan, at which point the road to Glykiotissa Church leaves the said main road ; thence northwards along the said road to Glykiotissa Church to the north-western corner of plot No. 18/2 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/12 ; thence northwards along the western boundary of plot No. 15/3 of the said plan to the point of commencement ; all which said boundary includes the area coloured red, yellow, blue and green on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1157.

SCHEDULE B.

Quarters of the Town of Kyrenia.

1. The Kato Kyrenia quarter comprising :—

- (a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarter aforesaid ; and
- (b) the following area hitherto forming part of the village area of Templos, that is to say, the boundary commences at the north-western corner of plot No. 15/3 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/12, on the seashore, and proceeds eastwards along the seashore to the most northern point of plot No. 17/1 of the said plan ; thence southwards along the western boundaries of plots Nos. 17/1 of the said plan and 157/4 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/20 to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned plot, on the main road from Kyrenia to Lapithos ; thence westwards along the said main road to the south-western corner of plot No. 26/2 of the said plan, at which point the road to Glykiotissa Church leaves the said main road ; thence northwards along the said road to Glykiotissa Church to the north-western corner of plot No. 18/2 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/12 ; thence northwards along the western boundary of plot No. 15/3 of the said plan to the point of commencement ; all which said boundary includes the area coloured blue on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1157,

2. The Pano Kyrenia quarter comprising :—

- (a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarter aforesaid ; and
 (b) the following area hitherto forming part of the village area of Templos, that is to say—

The boundary commences at the north-western corner of plot No. 42 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/20, at which point a track from Templos joins the main road from Lapithos to Kyrenia, and proceeds eastwards along the said main road to the stream at the north-western corner of plot No. 195/1 of the said plan ; thence southwards along the said stream to the most western point of the last-mentioned plot, which point is on the lower road from Templos to Kyrenia ; thence north-eastwards along the said road to the most northern point of plot No. 78 of the said plan ; thence southwards, eastwards and southwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 78 and 85 of the said plan to the most eastern point of the last-mentioned plot, which point is on the upper road from Kyrenia to Templos ; thence south-westwards along the said road to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 88 of the said plan ; thence southwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 88, 89, 156 and 121 of the said plan to the south-western corner of the last-mentioned plot, which point is on the stream "Kalava Deresi" ; thence northwards down the said stream to the lower road from Kyrenia to Templos ; thence south-westwards along the said road to the south-western corner of plot No. 67 of the said plan, which point is on a track leading to main road from Lapithos to Kyrenia ; thence north-westwards and north-eastwards along the said track to the point of commencement ; all which said boundary includes the area coloured green on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1157.

THE SHIPPING DUES LAWS, 1917 AND 1932.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1900

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Shipping Dues Laws, 1917 and 1932, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. There shall be exempt from the payment of all dues under the Shipping Dues Laws, 1917 and 1932, the following ships, that is to say,—

The steamers of the Palestine Maritime Lloyd, Ltd., in respect of five calls made by such steamers during the months of July, August and
