THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Wheaten Flour) Order, 1939.

2. Within twenty days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person (whether such person is a merchant, importer, dealer or otherwise) who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of wheaten flour exceeding in the aggregate 200 cokes in weight shall complete and deliver to the Commissioner of the District in which such person resides a return, in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto, in respect of the total quantity of such flour in his possession or under his control.

3. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize, by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under clause 2 of this Order.

4. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, or

(b) makes a false return under clause 2 of this Order,

shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Wheat) Order, 1939.

2. Within twenty days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person (whether such person is a merchant, importer, dealer or otherwise) who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of wheat exceeding in the aggregate 10 kilés shall complete and deliver to—

(a) in the case of a person residing in or carrying on business in a town, the Commissioner of the District in which such town is situated, or

(b) in the case of a person residing in or carrying on business in a village, to the Mukhtar of the village in which he resides, a return, in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto, in respect of the total quantity of wheat in his possession or under his control.

3. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize, by writing in that behalf, to enter upon
