THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Kerosene) Amendment (No. 4) Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Kerosene) Orders, 1939 to (No. 3) 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Kerosene) Orders, 1939 to (No. 4) 1939.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Schedule is substituted therefor:—

3. Kyrenia, Polis, Morphou, Xeros and Lapithos.	42½ <i>piastres</i>	48½ <i>piastres</i>	do.
4. Any other town or village not specifically enumerated above.	42½ <i>piastres</i>	48½ <i>piastres</i>	do."
