## THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Sale of Imported Seed Potatoes Restriction) Order, 1939.
- 2. From and after the date of the publication of this Order in the Gazette, no importer of seed potatoes shall sell or otherwise dispose of any imported seed potatoes except under and in virtue of a special permit issued under my hand.
- 3. Every special permit issued under the provisions of clause 2 of this Order may contain such terms and conditions (including the price at which the imported seed potatoes are to be sold) as may be specified therein.
- 4. Any person who acts in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, or of any of the terms or conditions contained in a special permit issued under this Order, shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939.

## No. 412. Notification under the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936.

AYIOS THEODHOROS (LARNACA) FUND.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, I hereby establish a fund for the village of Ayios Theodhoros, in the District of Larnaca (hereinafter called "the Fund"), into which shall be paid all fines recovered under the said Laws for offences committed within the Tree Planting Area of the village of Ayios Theodhoros, as described in the Order of the Governor made the 9th day of December, 1939, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette No. 2801 of the 13th December, 1939.

The Fund shall be under the management and control of the Commissioner of Larnaca for the time being.

The money in the Fund shall be utilized for works of public utility within the village of Ayios Theodhoros.
