In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1939, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Amendment (No. 2) Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Orders, 1936 to 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Customs (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Orders, 1936 to (No. 2) 1939.

2. The Second Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraphs 1 to 5, both inclusive.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1940.
