THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

W. D. BATTERSHILL, Governor,

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Mora, in the District of Nicosia, on the 11th day of August, 1939, it was determined by the requisite majority of the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Mora.

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have been fixed and described:

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Mora has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Nicosia a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, prescribed:

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor:

And whereas the Governor considers it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the area in the said report described should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Mora:
