THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1939.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1904

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1939, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Certain Goods (Restriction) Amendment Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Importation of Certain Goods (Restriction) Order, 1939, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Importation of Certain Goods (Restriction) Orders, 1939.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the following items:—

" Artificial silk piece goods.
Cotton piece goods."

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1940.
