THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1856
MADE UNDER SECTION 59.

H. R. PALMER, Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 59 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Potatoes) Order, 1939.

2. The exportation of potatoes to the United Kingdom between the 15th May, 1939, and the 30th October, 1939, both days inclusive, is prohibited save under the authority of a licence granted by the Director of Agriculture and subject to such terms and conditions as may be prescribed in such licence.

THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

H. R. PALMER,

Governor.

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Kiti, in the District of Larnaca, on the 14th day of August, 1938, it was determined by the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Kiti.

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have

been fixed and described:

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Kiti has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Larnaca a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and

stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, prescribed:

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor:

And whereas the Governor considers it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the area in the said report described should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Kiti:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be and shall be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Kiti, in the District of Larnaca.

SCHEDULE.

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say:-

The boundary commences at the most western point of plot No. 223 of the Government Survey plan No. $\hat{L}/30$, locality "Yephyra," on the road from the village of Kiti to the village of Meneou, and proceeds north-eastwards along the eastern side of the said road to the most northern point of plot No. 4 of the Government Survey plan No. L/31, locality "Ghoupa"; thence south-eastwards along the boundaries of, and including, plots Nos. 4, 9, 8, 17, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 26 of the said plan, to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 26, which point is on the road from the village of Meneou to the village of Perivolia; thence southwards along the said road to the most southern point of plot No. 66 of the Government Survey plan No. L/39, locality "Kokkines," at which point the road is joined by a footpath; thence north-westwards along the said footpath to the most western point of plot No. 159 of the Government Survey plan No. L/38, locality "Kokkines," which point is at the junction of two footpaths; thence north-eastwards along the footpath to the most western point of plot No. 23 of the Government Survey plan No. L/39, which point is on the left bank of the river "Trimithous"; thence north-westwards along the left bank of the said river to the point of commencement, all which said area is 1,490 donums or thereabouts, as shown edged in red on the plan filed in D.L.R.S. M.P. 635/38.
