In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, His Excellency the Governor, on the report of the Director of Education, is pleased to order and hereby orders that the Village Commissions for Moslem Schools in the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall in their respective villages provide, erect, repair, extend, improve or develop any school buildings, premises, play grounds, yards, gardens or teachers' dwellings, as the case may be, particulars whereof are given in the second column of the said Schedule.

**No. 83.****THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO (No. 2) 1937.****ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 71.**

Whereas His Excellency the Governor has, under section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, by Order published under Notification No. 71 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* dated the 6th day of April, 1939, ordered the Committee of Management for Maronite Schools to provide a site and school garden in the village of Ayia Marina Skillouras, in the District of Nicosia, and repair the school building in the village of Asomatos, in the District of Kyrenia :

And whereas the necessary estimates and plans have been prepared under section 53 of the above-mentioned Laws :

And whereas loans amounting to the sums mentioned in the third column of the Schedule hereto have, under section 51 (1), been raised to meet the expense of such buildings as aforesaid :

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by section 71 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to (No. 2) 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered that in order

to provide for the annual interest and sinking fund in respect of the loans aforesaid the sums of money mentioned in the fourth column of the said Schedule hereto be recovered from the Maronite inhabitants of the villages mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule in manner provided by section 74 (1) of the above Laws.

**THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.**

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Knodhara, in the District of Famagusta, on the 29th day of July, 1938, it was determined by the requisite majority of the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Knodhara.

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have been fixed and described :

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Knodhara has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Famagusta a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, prescribed :

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor :

And whereas the Governor has decided to limit the area in the said report described :

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 13 of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—
