## THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1939 TO (No. 1) 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939 to (No. 1) 1939, I hereby order as follows:-
