THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939 TO (No. 1) 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939 to (No. 1) 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Amendment (No. 3) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Orders, 1940 to (No. 2) 1940, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Orders, 1940 to (No. 3) 1940.

2. Part 8 of the First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Part is substituted therefor:—

"PART 8.—RICE.
