THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1939.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1944

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Stroumbi to contract a loan.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1939, do hereby order as follows :---

The Village Health Commission of Stroumbi (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as the "lenders") the sum of thirty pounds (£30) at a rate of interest not exceeding five per centum (5%) per annum subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say :—

(a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Village Health Commission to the lenders in five equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest).
