

In exercise of the powers verted in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939 to 1940, I hereby order as follows —

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Amendment (Nb. 8) Order, 1940, and shall be read as *G* one with the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Orders, S 1940 to (No. 7) 1940, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), N and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Orders, 1940 to (No. 8) 1940.

2. Part 19 of the First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Part is substituted therefor :---

No. 148. Notification under the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936.

AYIOS YEORYIOS (LIMASSOL) FUND.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, I hereby establish a fund for the village of Ayios Yeoryios, in the District of Limassol (hereinafter called "the Fund"), into which shall be paid all fines recovered under the said Laws for offences committed within the Tree Planting Area of Ayios Yeoryios, as described in the Order of the Governor made the 5th February, 1940, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* No. 2813 of the 14th February, 1940.

The Fund shall be under the management and control of the Commissioner of Limassol for the time being.

The money in the Fund shall be utilized for works of public utility in the village of Ayios Yeoryios.
