

No. 151. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1940.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66.

It is hereby notified that by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 66 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940, and duly delegated to me, I hereby approve the premises described in the Schedule hereto to be private warehouses for the warehousing of the goods set out in the corresponding item in the fourth column of the said Schedule without payment of import duties upon the first entry therein of such goods, with effect from the 6th November, 1939.
