## THE LANDING AND SHIPPING CHARGES LAW, 1933.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1947

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Landing and Shipping Charges Law, 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

This Order may be cited as the Landing and Shipping Charges (Amendment) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Landing and Shipping Charges (No. 2) Order, 1933, and the Landing and Shipping Charges (No. 2) Amendment Order, 1933, (hereinafter together referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Landing and Shipping Charges (No. 2) Order, 1933 and 1940.
