DIRECTION, ORDERS AND REGULATIONS.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by the Boats Regulation Law, 1884, and otherwise, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make and hereby makes the following Direction, Orders and Regulations :—

1. These Direction, Orders and Regulations may be cited as the Boats Direction, Orders and Regulations, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Boats Direction, Orders and Regulations, 1928 to 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Direction, Orders and Regulations") and the principal Direction, Orders and Regulations and these Direction, Orders and Regulations may together be cited as the Boats Direction, Orders and Regulations, 1928 to 1940.
