THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939 TO 1940.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939 to 1940, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Amendment (No. 10) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Orders, 1940 to (No. 9) 1940, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Orders, 1940 to (No. 10) 1940.

2. Part 10 of the First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Part is substituted therefor:—

"PART 10.—COTTON SEED OIL.

<i>Type of Cotton Seed Oil.</i>	<i>Retail Price.</i>	<i>Wholesale Price.</i>
1. Super Golden cotton seed oil.	20 piastres per litre.	27 piastres per litre.
2. Edible refined cotton seed oil.	27½ piastres per litre.	25½ piastres per litre.

In this Part of this Schedule—

- (a) the term 'cotton seed oil' does not include cotton seed oil which is sold in new sealed tins of less than 8 okes each, each of which is marked with a brand name;
- (b) the term 'Super Golden cotton seed oil' means refined cotton seed oil, of a pale yellow colour, perfectly clear, and entirely free from non-fatty matters;
- (c) the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of cotton seed oil of either type in quantities in excess of 5 litres at any one time or at any single transaction."

3. Part 11 of the First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Part is substituted therefor:—

"PART 11.—SOYA BEAN OIL.

<i>Type of Soya Bean Oil.</i>	<i>Retail Price.</i>	<i>Wholesale Price.</i>
Soya bean oil	38½ piastres per litre.	35½ piastres per litre.

In this Part of this Schedule—

the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of soya bean oil in quantities in excess of 5 litres at any one time or at any single transaction."

4. Part 13 of the First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Part is substituted therefor:—

"PART 13.—CONCENTRATED EDIBLE OIL.

<i>Type of Concentrated Edible Oil</i>	<i>Retail Price.</i>	<i>Wholesale Price.</i>
1. Ordinary concentrated edible oil.	19 piastres per oke.	16½ piastres per oke.
2. Concentrated edible oil in new sealed tins of 2 okes or less.	21½ piastres per oke.	19 piastres per oke.

In this Part of this Schedule—

- (a) the term 'concentrated edible oil' means the substance commonly known as 'phagosimon lipos' or 'technikos voutiros';
- (b) the term 'wholesale' means—
- (i) in respect of ordinary concentrated edible oil, sale or purchase thereof in quantities in excess of 10 okes at any one time or at any single transaction, and
- (ii) in respect of concentrated edible oil in new sealed tins of 2 okes or less, sale or purchase thereof in quantities of not less than five such tins at any one time or at any single transaction."
