SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 238. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Stocks of Cotton) Order, 1940.

2. Within five days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person who has in his possession or under his control any cotton whether ginned or unginned exceeding in the aggregate 200 okes in weight shall complete and deliver to the Commissioner of the District in which such person resides a return, in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto, in respect of the total quantity of cotton in his possession or under his control.

3. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize by writing in that behalf to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under clause 2 of this Order.

4. Any person who—

- (a) acts in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, or
- (b) makes a return under clause 2 of this Order which is false in any material particular,

shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940.
