No. 241. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 21 (1).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Regulation 21 (1) of the Defence Regulations, 1940, do hereby order as follows:—

1. All persons in the Colony, other than enemy aliens, are hereby exempted from the provisions of Regulation 21 (1) of the Defence Regulations, 1940:

Provided that no person shall have a camera in his possession, or take any photograph of any place, matter or thing situate in any prohibited area as defined in the Prohibited Areas Order, 1940.

No. 242. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 22 (1) (c).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Regulation 22 (1) (c) of the Defence Regulations, 1940, do hereby order as follows:—

1. Any alien who intends to be absent from his place of residence for more than six consecutive hours shall—

(a) present himself to the Police Station nearest to his place of residence before departure;

(b) present himself on arrival at the place of destination to the nearest Police Station and also to the same Police Station upon departure from such place;

(c) present himself to the nearest Police Station on return to his place of residence:

Provided that nothing in this Order shall apply to aliens who possess the nationality of a State which is allied to His Majesty in any war in which His Majesty may be engaged.
