THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940.

ORDER UNDER REGULATION 64.

W. D. BATTERSHILL,

Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Regulation 64 of the Defence Regulations, 1940, do hereby authorize the use of the buildings specified in the Schedule hereto, for military purposes as from 19th June, 1940, until further order.

SCHEDULE.

1. The building known as the 1st Elementary Boys and Girls Schools, Varosha, consisting of sixteen rooms, seven verandahs, two small store rooms, one tank, one wheel well, W.C. and yard.

Area: 8 donums, 1 evlek and 3,152 square feet.

Boundaries: Plot No. 8, Edith K. Karadja and others of Nicosia, and three sides road.

Registration No. 4263 of 3rd July, 1936.

Map reference: Block D, Plot 9, Varosha.

Registered owner: Mayor of Famagusta.

2. The building known as the Othello Hotel consisting of 18 upstairs rooms, 2 W.C.'s, 2 bathrooms, 1 hall, 3 downstairs rooms, 1 downstairs shop, 2 kitchens, 1 W.C.

Area: 2 evleks and 1,316 square feet.

Boundaries : Antonis Haji Panayi, road, Maria Louka Parikou, and Despinou Antoni Haji Panayi.

Registration No. 3278 of 29th December, 1930.

Map reference : Block D, Plot 12, Varosha.

Registered owners : $\frac{1}{2}$ Despinou Antoni Haji Panayi and $\frac{1}{2}$ Savvas Vrachimi.
