ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1956

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940, do hereby order as follows :

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Goods (Restriction) Order, 1940.

2. From and after the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* and notwithstanding anything in any other Order contained the importation into the Colony of any goods whatsoever is prohibited save under the authority of a licence granted by the Registrar of Co-operative Societies and subject to such terms and conditions as may be prescribed in such licence :

Provided that nothing in this Order contained shall apply—

- (a) to any goods proved to the satisfaction of the Comptroller of Customs and Inland Revenue to have been shipped to the Colony prior to the 9th day of December, 1939 ;
- (b) to any goods consigned through the Postal Service where the value of such goods does not exceed ~~two~~^{one} pounds and such goods are consigned to a private individual for his private use ;
- (c) to any *bona fide* baggage (as defined in item 9 of the Second Schedule to the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940) being the property of and accompanied by a passenger and proved to the satisfaction of the Comptroller of Customs and Inland Revenue to be for the personal use of such passenger.
