Condition.—Any person selling at the prices shown under paragraphs 4 and 5 shall keep on his premises a register showing the quantity of each purchase, the date and the person from whom the flour was purchased.”

B.—The Second Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 3 and the substitution therefor of the following part:—

No. 277. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 61 of the Cyprus Defence Regulations, 1940, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Return of Stocks of Wheat and Barley) Order, 1940.

2. Within fifteen days of the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person (whether such person is a merchant, importer, dealer or otherwise) who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of wheat and barley shall complete and deliver—

(a) in the case of a person residing in or carrying on business in a town, to the Commissioner of the District in which such town is situated; or
 (b) in the case of a person residing in or carrying on business in a village, to the Mukhtar of the village in which he resides,
 a return, in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto, in respect of the total quantity of wheat and barley in his possession or under his control.

3. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize, by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under clause 2 of this Order.

4. Any person who—

- (a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order, or
 (b) makes a return under clause 2 of this Order which is false in any material particular shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940.
