THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 AND 1940.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2 (1).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 (1) of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 and 1940, do hereby order that the following territories shall be treated as enemy territory for the purpose of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 and 1940 :—

- (a) Those parts of the Metropolis of France which are not included in the area occupied by Germany in accordance with the terms of the Franco-German Armistice Convention of 22nd June, 1940.
- (b) Algeria.
- (c) The French zone of Morocco.
- (d) Tunisia.

THE SUMMER RESORTS (DEVELOPMENT) LAW, 1938.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 43 of the Summer Resorts (Development) Law, 1938, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to direct and it is hereby directed that sections 39, 40, 41 and 42 of the said Law shall apply to any buildings erected or to be erected upon any land of the Arazi Mirié or the Arazi Mevkoufé Takhsisat category within the Summer Resort of Prodhromos, in the District of Limassol.
