THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 AND 1940.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 4 (2).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 (2) of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 and 1940, His Excellency the Governor, with the approval of the Secretary of State, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) Amendment (No. 3) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) Orders, 1940, to (No. 2) 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Specified Persons) Orders, 1940 to (No. 3) 1940.
