THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) (FINANCE) REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1940.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Regulation 5A of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1940, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Bank Notes) Prohibition of Import Order, 1940.
- 2. On and after the 28th day of August, 1940, no person shall import into the Colony except under licence issued by the Exchange Officer or any other person authorized by him in that behalf any:—

(a) Bank of England notes, or

(b) any Bank notes issued by any Bank in Scotland or Northern Ireland.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act, 1939, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1940.

Insertion of new paragraph in Regulation 66 of the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 66 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after paragraph (4) of the following paragraph:—

"(5) The Governor may, by order, if it appears to him expedient so to do, delegate to any person, subject to such limitations and directions as he may in such order provide, any of the powers conferred upon him by the preceding provisions of this Regulation, other than the power to requisition any vessel, ship or aircraft or anything on board any vessel, ship or aircraft."
