
ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940, I hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices Gazette) of Scheduled Articles) Consolidation Amendment Order, 1940, and shall Supplement be read as one with the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Consolidation Order, 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Consolidation Orders, 1940.
 - 2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) by the deletion in sub-paragraph 3 of the words "First and Second Schedules" and by the substitution therefor of the word "Schedule".
 - (b) by the deletion of sub-paragraph (4).
- 3. Clause 3 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "First and Second Schedules" wherever they occur in this clause and by the substitution therefor of the word "Schedule".

No. 3: 3.7.1940

- 4. Clause 8 of the principal Order is hereby revoked and the following clause substituted therefor:—
 - "8. No person who-
 - (a) carries on business in respect of any scheduled article shown in the Schedule, or
 - (b) holds a stock of any such article in excess of his reasonable domestic requirements for a period not exceeding one month, shall without good cause on demand being made to him by a prospective purchaser and on being offered the requisite purchase price, refuse to sell to him such article."
 - 5. Clause 11 of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—
 (a) by the deletion in sub-paragraph (1) of the words "shown in the First Schedule".
 - (b) by the deletion in sub-paragraph 2 of the words "shown in the First Schedule" (line 2) and of the word "First" (line 3).
- 6. The following clause shall be inserted in the principal Order immediately after Clause 11 thereof:—
 - "11A. No person shall sell wheat or barley otherwise than by weight.".
- 7. Clause 13 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "First and Second Schedules" and by the substitution therefor of the word "Schedule".
 - 8. Clause 14 of the principal Order is hereby repealed.
- 9. The First Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "First Schedule." appearing at the head thereof and by the substitution therefor of the word "Schedule.".
 - 10. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is hereby repealed.
