

4. Clause 8 of the principal Order is hereby revoked and the following clause substituted therefor :—

“ 8. No person who—

(a) carries on business in respect of any scheduled article shown in the Schedule, or

(b) holds a stock of any such article in excess of his reasonable domestic requirements for a period not exceeding one month,

shall without good cause on demand being made to him by a prospective purchaser and on being offered the requisite purchase price, refuse to sell to him such article.”

5. Clause 11 of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) by the deletion in sub-paragraph (1) of the words “ shown in the First Schedule ”.

(b) by the deletion in sub-paragraph 2 of the words “ shown in the First Schedule ” (line 2) and of the word “ First ” (line 3).

6. The following clause shall be inserted in the principal Order immediately after Clause 11 thereof :—

“ 11A. No person shall sell wheat or barley otherwise than by weight.”.

7. Clause 13 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “ First and Second Schedules ” and by the substitution therefor of the word “ Schedule ”.

8. Clause 14 of the principal Order is hereby repealed.

9. The First Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “ First Schedule.” appearing at the head thereof and by the substitution therefor of the word “ Schedule.”.

10. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is hereby repealed.

NOTICE No. 4 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 3 and the substitution therefor of the following part :—

“ PART 3.—AUSTRALIAN FLOUR. *has. in p. 880*

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 6 and the substitution thereof of the following part:—

"PART 6.—COFFEE.

"PART 28.—SODA CRYSTALS (Potassa).

the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of soda crystals in quantities of not less than one bag of approximately 70 okes.

(b) Exceptions—

- (i) Where sales by retail are made in villages from stocks bought before the 7th August, 1940, the retail price per oke shall not exceed the price per oke paid by the seller, plus 25%.
- (ii) Where sales by wholesale are made in towns from stocks bought before the 7th August, 1940, the price may be the wholesale price paid by the seller plus 10%."

- (b) The term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of olive oil in quantities in excess of 5 litres at any one time or at any single transaction.

## PART 31.—CONCENTRATED EDIBLE OIL.

In this Part of the Schedule—

- (a) the term 'concentrated edible oil' means the substance commonly known as 'phagosimon lipos' or 'technikos voutiros' and does not include concentrated edible oil which is sold in new sealed tins of two okes or less each of which is marked with a brand name.
- (b) the term 'wholesale' means the sale or purchase of concentrated edible oil in quantities in excess of 10 okes at any one time or at any single transaction.

## PART 32.—SOYA BEAN OIL.

(c) the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of cotton seed oil in quantities in excess of 5 litres at any one time or at any single transaction.
