**No. 356.****THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1940.****NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66.**

It is hereby notified that by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 66 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940, and duly delegated to me, I hereby order that store No. 3 described in item 2 of the Schedule to Notification No. 151 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 1st May, 1940, shall cease to be a private warehouse as from the 31st August, 1940, and that the said Schedule shall be amended by the deletion from the third column thereof, in respect of item 2, of the words "Two stores, Nos. 3 and 4" and by the substitution therefor of the words "The store No. 4".
