DELEGATION OF POWERS UNDER PARAGRAPH (5) OF REGULATION 66.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (5) of Regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1940, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to depute and hereby deputes each of the persons for the time being holding the offices designated in the second column of the Schedule hereto to exercise and perform on the Governor's behalf the powers mentioned in the first column of the said Schedule which the Governor is empowered to exercise or perform under the provisions of paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of Regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1940.

THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Potatoes) Order, 1940.

2. Within three days from the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* every person who, since the 1st June, 1939, has exported potatoes from the Colony, shall complete and deliver to me a return in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto in respect of the total quantity of potatoes in his possession or under his control. 3. Every such person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize, by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been, or are being, complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under clause 2 of this Order.

4. Any person who-

- (a) acts in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, or
- (b) makes under clause 2 of this Order a return which is false in any material particular, is liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940.
