REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence (Amendment No. 3) Regulations, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 3) 1940.
