

**No. 393. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1940.**

## NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66.

It is hereby notified that by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 66 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940, and duly deputed to me, I hereby approve the premises described in the third column of the Schedule hereto, belonging to the person whose name is set out in the first column of that Schedule and occupied by the firm whose name is set out in the second column of that Schedule, to be a private warehouse for the warehousing of the goods specified in the fourth column of the said Schedule without payment of import duties upon the first entry of such goods therein.

**No. 394. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940.**

## ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Cheese in Cold Storage) Order, 1940.

2. For the purposes of this Order—

“cheese” means locally-produced cheese of the kinds known as *kaskavalli* and *kefalotiri*.

3. On and from the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no cheese kept or deposited, or to be kept or deposited, in the Cyprus Cold Stores Limited at Nicosia, shall be withdrawn from such stores, or shall be sold or otherwise disposed of, except under the authority of a licence under my hand and subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified in such licence.

4. Any person who acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order, or of any of the terms and conditions specified in a licence issued thereunder, is liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940.
