THE WHEAT AND FLOUR (IMPORT DUTIES OF CUSTOMS VARIATION) LAW, 1938.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Wheat and Flour (Import Duties of Customs Variation) Law, 1938, and of every other power hereunto enabling do hereby order as follows:—

The Wheat and Flour (Duties of Customs Variation) (No. 2) Order, 1940, is hereby revoked as from the 25th day of October, 1940, without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

No. 404. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1940.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1976

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Wheat) Exemption

2. From and after the 25th day of October, 1940, all wheat imported into the Colony shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.
