No. 466. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1982

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) Order, 1940.

2. The respective rates of postage and charges set forth in the First Schedule hereto shall be charged by or under the Postmaster-General on all postal packets conveyed or delivered for conveyance by post.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1941, and thereupon the Orders in Council set out in the Second Schedule shall be revoked.

For every postal packet, irrespective of weight, handed in at any Post Office after the ordinary hours of collection . . . . .	1
<i>Duty Collection Fee :</i>	
For every postal packet (including parcels) delivered in Cyprus upon which Customs duty has to be collected . . . . .	3
<i>Poste Restante Fee :</i>	
(Where there is a House-to-House Delivery Service).	
For every postal packet addressed " Poste Restante " and delivered in Cyprus . . . . .	0½
<i>Express Search Fee :</i>	
(Where there is a House-to-House Delivery Service).
