No. 492. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1939.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1939, do hereby order that the Order in Council made on the 27th day of December, 1939, under the said section and published in the *Gazette* of the 27th day of December, 1939, shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "1st January, 1941," appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the words "1st January, 1942."

No. 493. THE CUSTOMS (EXPORT DUTY) LAW, 1940.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2005

MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Export Duty) (Goods for Military Purposes) Order (No. 2), 1940.

2. From and after the 31st day of January, 1940, all rates of export duty set forth in the Schedule to the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, payable in respect of the goods therein specified, which are certified by an officer of His Majesty's Forces to be exported for military purposes, are cancelled.

3. The Customs (Export Duty) (Goods for Military Purposes) Order, 1940, is hereby revoked.
