ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1923

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1939, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Certain Goods (Restriction) Amendment (No. 4) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Importation of Certain Goods (Restriction) Orders, 1939 to (No. 3) 1940, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Importation of Certain Goods (Restriction) Orders, 1939 to (No. 4) 1940.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following item:—

"Apparel of artificial silk or of artificial silk combined with any other material."

No. 56. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1936.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to improve the location of the Nicosia-Kondea Road by deviations between mile posts 6 and 7 in the District of Nicosia and to bypass the villages of Asha, Vatili and Lysi, in the District of Famagusta:

Now, therefore, I, William Denis Battershill, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1936, do hereby declare the acquisition of land for the aforesaid purposes to be an undertaking of public utility, and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust to the Director of Public Works the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking.
