2. Within twenty days from the date of the publication of this Order in the Gazette, every person who, sihce the lst day of October, 1939, has sown any lands with wheat or barley, whether as owner or lessee or cultivator in partnership of such lands or otherwise, shall declare to the Mukhtar of the town, village or quằrter within the limits of which such lands are situated the number of Government donums of land sown with wheat and/or barley, as the case may be.
3. Any person who-
(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, the provisions of clause 2 of this Order, or
(b) makes, under clause 2 of this Order, a declaration which is false in any material particular,
shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939 to (No. 1) 1939.
