SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 119. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1941.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER REGULATION 70.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 70 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1941, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited Areas Order, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Prohibited Areas Orders, 1940 to (No. 4) 1941 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Prohibited Areas Orders, 1940 to 1941.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after Area No. 1A under the heading of "Famagusta Town and Harbour Prohibited Area", of a new Area No. 1B, as specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

Area No. 1 B.

Commencing at a point on the sea-wall on the Northern Side of the entrance to Famagusta Harbour; thence seawards in a true North-East direction a distance of 6,500 feet; thence in a true South-East direction a distance of 5,200 feet; thence in a true South-West direction a distance of 6,100 feet to a point on the shore about 150 feet North-East of the Old Slaughter-House; thence following the shore line North-westerly along the eastern shores of the islands of Nisi tou Jieri, Nisi Megalon (Oxonisi) and Nisi ton Maymounion to the extreme northerly point of Nisi ton Maymounion; thence westerly along the northern edge of the sea-wall to the point of commencement. The whole area comprises approximately 1 Square Mile of Sea.
