CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940.**

NOTICE NO. 30 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 2 and the substitution therefor of the following part:—

“PART 2.—BARLEY.

Modification :

Any foreign ingredient or extraneous matter in any barley in excess of the maximum percentage of 4% permitted by the Adulteration of Produce (Local Sales) Regulations, 1940 and 1941, shall not be paid for and there may be deducted from the price of such barley, by the purchaser or the person taking delivery, any expenses required or incurred for cleaning such barley from any foreign ingredient or extraneous matter in excess of 4% as aforesaid.”
