No. 139. THE CYPRUS GOVERNMENT RAILWAY LAW, 1906.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

W. D. BATTERSHILL,

Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Cyprus Government Railway Law, 1906, do hereby make the following regulations :-

1. These regulations may be cited as the Railway (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Railway Regulations, 1939 to 1941 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Railway Regulations, 1939 to (No. 2) 1941.

2. The following Part of the First Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows :-

PART XIII.—SPECIAL RATES AND FARES FOR HIS MAJESTY'S FORCES.

By the deletion of paragraph (1) and the substitution therefor of the following :-

"(1)—(i) Animals and munitions... (ii) Other goods, including baggage ... Class 6."

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1941.

No. 140. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1941.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 55.

W. D. BATTERSHILL,

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 55 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, do hereby order as follows:—
1. This Order may be cited as the Pedal Bicycles (Control) Order, 1941.

2. From and after the 12th day of June, 1941, no person shall between 10 p.m. and sunrise of the following morning use any pedal bicycle on any road in the Colony without permission in writing from the Police Officer in charge of a District.

3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to pedal bicycles used exclusively by His Majesty's Forces or by any member of the Cyprus Police Force or Air Raid Precautions Organization on duty as such.
