THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Defence (Amendment No. 3) Regulations, 1941, and shall be read as one with the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 3) 1941.

2. The following regulation shall be inserted in the principal Regulations immediately after regulation 66 thereof:—

66A.—(1) The Governor, in any case where in his opinion there are such conditions of emergency as to make it necessary for the efficient prosecution of the war, may by order require all banks or other persons with whom securities or other valuables which may be specified in such order have been deposited—
(a) to remove such securities or valuables to any place inside or outside the Colony, to be designated by the Governor; or
(b) to transfer such securities or valuables into the custody of the Government.
(2) No person acting under this regulation shall, so long as he acts in good faith, be under liability, either civil or criminal, by reason of anything done or omitted to be done by him."

THE POLICE LAWS, 1878 TO 1940.
