A LAW TO AMEND THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY
LAWS, 1939 TO (No. 2) 1940.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Trading with the
Enemy (Amendment) Law, 1941, and shall be read as one
with the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to (No. 2)
1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and
the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as
the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1941.

2. Sub-section (2) of section 3 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraph (ii) of the proviso and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph :—

“(ii) received payment from an enemy of a sum of money due in respect of a transaction under which all obligations on the part of the person receiving payment had already been performed when the payment was received, and had been performed at a time when the person from whom the payment was received was not an enemy.”

3. Sub-section (5) of section 5 of the principal Law is hereby repealed.

4. The proviso to sub-section (3) of section 6 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “a court of a State at war with His Majesty” and the substitution therefor of the words “a court having jurisdiction in enemy territory”.
