1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Bananas and Mangoes) Exemption Order, 1941.
2. From and after the lst day of July, 1941, all bananas and mangoes imported into the Colony shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.

## No. 159. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 3) 1941.

Delegation of Power under Paragraph (5) of Regulation 66.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (5) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 3) 1941, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to depute and hereby deputes the persons for the time being holding the offices designated in the second column of the Schedule hereto to exercise and perform on the Governor's behalf the powers mentioned in the first column of the said Schedule which the Governor is empowered to exercise and perform under the provisions of paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 3) 1941.
2. The Notification No. 108, published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 14th May, 1941, is hereby revoked.

## Schedule.

The power to requisition any mechanically propelled vehicle and the powers connected with such requisitioning conferred by paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 3) 1941.

1. Commissioner of each District.
2. Commissioner of Police.
3. Police Officer in charge of a District.
4. Registrar of Co-operative Societies.
