THE ROADS PROTECTION LAW, 1885.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 1.

W. D. BATTERSHILL, Governor.

- I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Roads Protection Law, 1885, do hereby order as follows:—
 - 1. This Order may be cited as the Roads Protection Order, 1941.
- All public roads in the Colony, used as public thoroughfares, shall be subject to the provisions of the Roads Protection Law, 1885.
