THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES)
CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940.

NOTICE No. 34 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 26 and the substitution therefor of the following part :—

“PART 26.—WHOLE WHEAT FLOUR.

Definition.—‘ Whole wheat flour ’ shall have the same meaning as in the Defence (Sale of Barley Flour and Wheat Flour) Order, 1940.

Condition.—Any person selling at the prices shown under paragraphs 4 and 5 shall keep on his premises a register showing the quantity of each purchase, the date and the person from whom the flour was purchased.”

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 4 and the substitution therefor of the following part :—

“PART 4.—LOCALLY-MADE MACARONI.

Kind of locally-made macaroni	Retail price	Wholesale price
Made from local wheaten flour or imported flour	9 piastres per oke	8 piastres per oke

In this Part of the Schedule—

the term ‘ wholesale ’ means sale or purchase of locally-made macaroni in quantities of not less than one case of 18 to 20 okes in weight at any one time or at any single transaction.”
