No. 183. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

No. 184. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1940.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 66.

It is hereby notified that by virtue of the powers vested in the Governor by section 66 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940, and duly deputed to me, I hereby approve the premises described in the third column of the Schedule hereto, belonging to the person whose name is set out in the first column of that Schedule and occupied by the firm whose name is set out in the second column of that Schedule, to be a private warehouse for the warehousing of the goods specified in the fourth column of the said Schedule without payment of import duties upon the first entry of such goods therein.

No. 185. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 3) 1941.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 3) 1941, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence ((Conditions of Sale) Repeal Order, 1941.

2. The Defence (Conditions of Sale) Order, 1939, is hereby repealed without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 19th day of July, 1941.
